International Student Admission Procedures



Guidelines



Confirm your eligibility to apply as an international student.

Check the deadline for department and semester of desired enrollment.



Bring your diploma(issued by an academic institution outside of Taiwan), official transcript, and statement of financial resources(usually issued by the bank) to the nearest R.O.C. Embassy, Taiwan Consulate Office, or Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in your country of residence for authentication.

Every year, applicants are required to submit all application material to Office of Academic Affairs during:
Feb. 1- Apr. 30 (Enrollment in Fall)
Oct. 15- Nov. 15 (Enrollment in Spring)

Applicants will be notified:
Jun. (Fall enrollment)&
Dec. (Spring enrollment)

Registration begins in
mid-Sep. (Fall)&
mid- Feb. (Spring)



Scholarships

Huayu Enrichment Scholarship



1. Eligibility
The international students (Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao SAR students are not eligible) to undertake Huayu courses in the R.O.C.(Taiwan).

2. Award Value
A Monthly stipend of 25,000 NTD.

Taiwan Scholarship



1. Eligibility
The outstanding international students (with the exception of students from the Mainland Area, Hong Kong, and Macau) to undertake degree studies in Taiwan.

2. Award Value
a monthly stipend of NTD15,000 for undergraduate studies; a monthly stipend of NTD20,000 for master's degree or doctorate studies.

MOFA Taiwan Scholarship



1. Eligibility
In principle, granted to students from countries that have diplomatic relations with Taiwan. However, special consideration may also be given to students from other countries.

2. Award Value
A Monthly stipend of 25,000 NTD to 30,000NTD.
